

Holiday at Home Parade

Rules and Regulations

Please read the following rules and regulations for the Holiday at Home parade. Any questions should be forwarded to the Parade Chairperson, Don Schweitzer, at 643-3820 or dschweitzer@dayair.org.

1. All children walking in the parade must be supervised from outside vehicle(s) if there is a vehicle in the unit. Children **must** remain behind the vehicle during the parade. (WARNING: This is a long parade route please have smaller children rider and older children walk.)
2. Any sign on a vehicle must be in good taste. Lettering is not to be any larger than six inches high. The Parade Chairperson shall be the final authority on this issue.
3. Distributing candy or any other items from the parade unit or float during the parade are **not** permitted. Any group found doing so will be asked to stop and will **not** be invited to the next year's parade.
4. Once your unit is started down the parade route **KEEP MOVING!!!** Units are not permitted to stop along the parade route or in front of the reviewing stand for any reason. Parade marshals will be stationed along the parade route to keep traffic moving.
5. Parade units that are sponsored by or have use of equipment through the donation of a business may recognize such with a sign that complies with rule #1 above. The sign must have "Sponsored by..." or "Courtesy of ..." as part of the lettering of the sign.
6. Any person other than the reigning Holiday at Home Queen is not permitted to wear crowns, tiaras, or similar headpieces, as this parade is intended to honor the Queen and her court. Anyone found wearing a crown, tiara or similar headpiece will be instructed to remove it by the parade marshals.
7. Groups will be limited to **four** motorized vehicles. Exceptions may be permitted depending on their use in the parade, (i.e. carrying handicapped children, senior citizens, etc.), please check with the parade Chairperson for approval.
8. Any vehicle in the parade **must**, upon request, show proof of insurance, in accordance with Kettering Holiday at Home Foundation, Inc. Bylaw, Article 4.01. Vehicles without proper insurance will **not** be allowed to go down the parade route.
9. If you enter a float into the parade, you should have received special instructions on where to stage and what time to arrive. In addition, you should have received information on float building hours. The float building is Building 2 in the Kettering Business Park (formerly DESC site).
