

2012 POSTER CONTEST

RULES:

- Applicants must be in grades 1-12 with a limit of one entry (poster) per student.
- Posters must express this year's theme, "*Holiday at Home Puts on the Glitz.*"
- Posters must be the student's original artwork. Posters containing copyrighted characters or clip art will be disqualified.
- The minimum poster size is 8½" X 11" and the maximum is 24" X 36" (Height x Width). Landscape layout only. The posters will be on public display and should be easy to see and/or read.
- The student's name should not appear on the front of the poster.
- The Holiday at Home Committee (H@H) reserves the right to disqualify a poster due to inappropriate content.

AWARDS:

- Each poster will be placed in one of four separate categories: 1st through 3rd grades, 4th through 5th grades, 6th through 8th grades, and 9th through 12th grades.
- There will be one award for each category and an overall Grand Prize Award.
- Awards are sponsored by Town and Country Shopping Center and Designs Now.

IMPORTANT DATES:

- Posters must be submitted to the management office at Town and Country Shopping Center by the close of business on May 14, 2012. Posters received after that date will **NOT** be accepted.
- The winners will be contacted in June via personal phone call. The winner's names and poster details will then be released to the media.
- All posters will be on public display at Town and Country Shopping Center during the month of July. Non-winning posters may be reclaimed at Town and Country beginning August 1, 2012.
- The award winners will be recognized at the H@H "Kick-Off Reception" on August 22 at Polen Farm. The posters will be displayed during the Labor Day festivities both at the H@H Information booth and on a float in the Labor Day Parade.
